Scholarship Policy

Objectives of the Scholarship Policy

- To promote academic excellence by rewarding meritorious students and supporting those from disadvantaged backgrounds, while encouraging participation in specific fields of study.
- To facilitate students' access to various scholarship opportunities by providing clear guidance and support throughout the application process.
- To scrutinize and verify documents for eligibility under different scholarship schemes, ensuring compliance with relevant guidelines.
- To receive, evaluate, and recommend scholarship applications for further consideration by the appropriate authorities.

PCTM Scholarship Policy

PCTM has established a comprehensive scholarship policy outlining the rules and guidelines in place since the college's inception. The policy covers the awarding of scholarships based on merit and the government's reservation policy for enrolled students.

Each academic year, the college aims to provide a scholarship to a deserving student in each discipline. Additional forms of financial support may also be granted, subject to the availability of sponsored funds and compliance with governmental guidelines.

The selection process involves meritorious students submitting applications. Special consideration is given to students with exceptional skills in areas such as sports, arts, cultural talents, differently-abled individuals, and other unique abilities.

A scholarship committee established by the college reviews all applications and recommends eligible candidates for scholarships and financial assistance. In cases of dispute, the Director holds the final authority to approve scholarship awards.

The college offers two types of scholarships: "Category A" and "Category B."

“Category A”

A (1) – Merit-Based Scholarships.

Scholarships are awarded to students based on their **academic performance** in Grade 12 as follows:

Eligibility Criteria (Grade 12 Performance)	Scholarship Amount (INR)
70% – 79.99%	₹2,500
80% – 89.99%	₹5,000
90% and above	₹7,500

Merit-Based Scholarships for Second and Third-Year Students

- Students who maintain **80% or higher** in each semester during their **II and III years** will receive a scholarship of ₹5,000 per academic year

A (2). **BPL Scholarship**

- Awarded to students demonstrating financial need as assessed through a comprehensive evaluation process.
- Financial documents such as income certificate (income less than 1.5 lakh/yr.), ration card and family circumstances will be considered.
- Awarded only at the time of admission.
- The value for scholarship will Rs. 5000.

A (3). **Student Reference Scholarship**

- Awarded to students referring new students to PCTM
- The value for scholarship will be 20% of the tuition fee after the admission confirmation of the new student (submission of the semester fee), and will be applicable on the next semester fee.
- Awarded only once.

A (4). **CUET-Based Scholarships.**

Scholarships are awarded to students based on their **CUET** as follows:

Eligibility Criteria (CUET percentile)	Scholarship Amount (INR)
70 – 79.99	₹2,000
80 – 89.99	₹4,000
90 -94.99	₹6,000
95 and above	₹7,500

A (5). **Defense Scholarship** **ARMY/NAVY/AIRFORCE/ BSF/CRPF/ITBP etc.**

- In case the parent of the new student belongs to the above-mentioned category; the student will be eligible for a scholarship of 15% of the 1st semester tuition fee.
- Awarded only once- for the first semester.
- In case the parents are deceased the student will be eligible for an additional scholarship of 10% of the tuition fee for the remaining semesters.

A (6). **Sports Scholarship**

- In case the enrolling student is a **State level** player with a valid certificate (valid only for one year) then the student will be eligible for the value for scholarship will be 15% of the tuition fee.
- In case the enrolling student is a **National level** player with a valid certificate (valid only for one year) then the student will be eligible for the value for scholarship will be 20% of the tuition fee.
- Awarded only once- for the first semester.
- In case the student will participate in any National / State level sport in 1st & 2nd year, will be eligible for Scholarship per academic year in II & III years.

“Category B”

B (1). Early Bird Scholarship

- First 75 students completing the registration will be eligible for a registration fee waiver and will submit **Rs.10000** as part of the semester tuition fee. In case of withdrawal the registration fee Rs. 2000 will be deducted, remaining **Rs.8000** will be refunded as per the refund policy.

B (2). Women Empowerment Scholarship

- Female student enrolling for new course will be eligible for a scholarship of 10% of the semester tuition fee.
- Awarded only once- for the first semester.

* All the above-mentioned scholarships are applicable for KU programs only.

* **Only one sub-scholarship from Category A and one sub-scholarship from Category B can be availed at a time. However, scholarships from Category A and Category B can be combined.**

* For student enrolling for the UOU courses and eligible for any of the above category they will be entitled for Rs.5000 only (one time only)

Lump Sum Scholarship (Policy Clause)

A Lump Sum Scholarship of ₹2,500 shall be awarded as a one-time financial grant for one academic year only. The scholarship shall be applicable only upon submission of the full first-year fee at the time of admission and is subject to fulfillment of the prescribed eligibility criteria and verification of required documents. This scholarship is over and above other applicable scholarship policies of the institution.
