# A Budget Review and Discussion Session by B.Com(H)

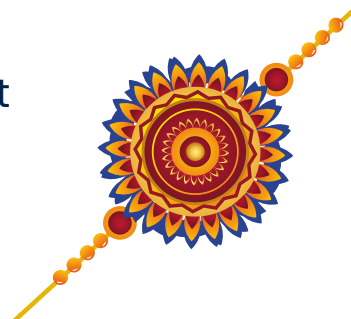

## Bakery Practical

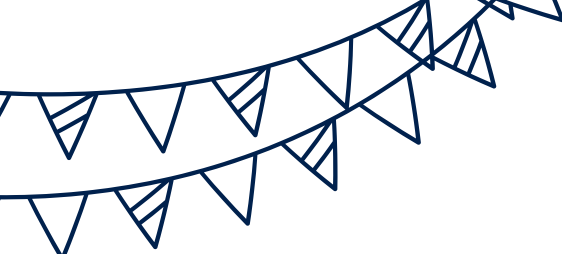

# Career Guidance Sessions

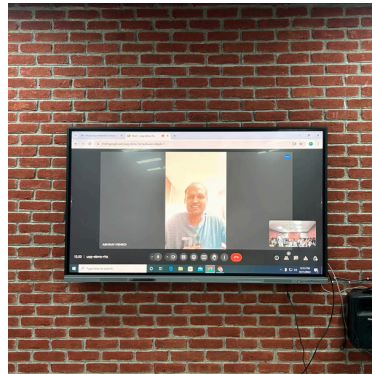
SEPTEMBER
