
This sacred occasion, dedicated to Goddess Saraswati, conveys a message of knowledge, energy, and positivity.


STRIDE | PCTM Annual Athletic Meet 2026


We are delighted to share that Vedika Upadhyay (Biotech II Semester) secured 2nd position in the Poster Presentation.
