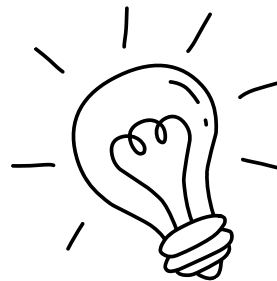
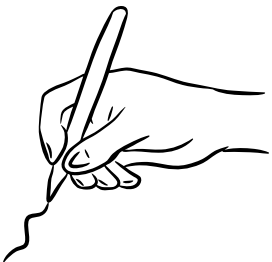
Poster Making Activity at Pal College of Technology & Management on 8 August 2025 as part of the Independence Day celebrations.

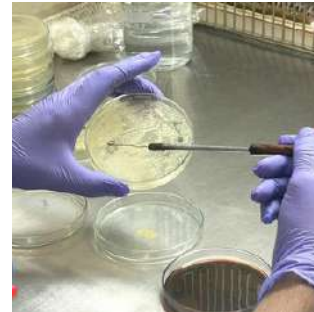

Exploring Science Beyond the Classroom at PCTM!

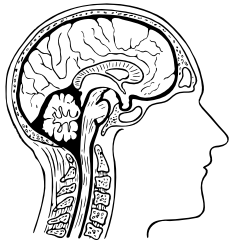

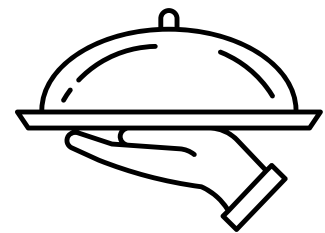

Learning the Art of Room Service

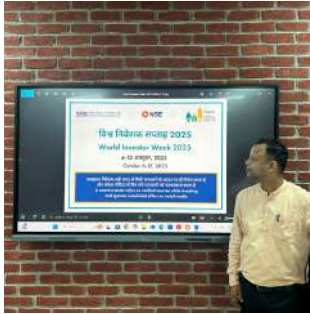
A Practical Experience at Pal College of Hotel Management!

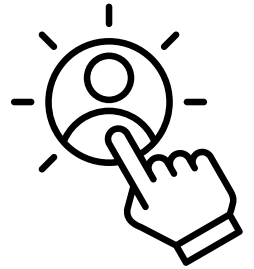


A mock interview drive was conducted for B.Sc. Biotechnology students at PCTM

Almora Literature Festival

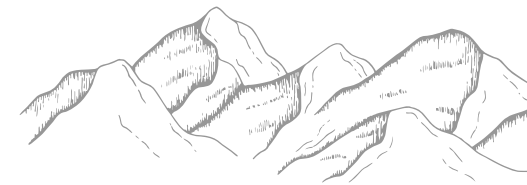

AI-Based Micro SaaS Development

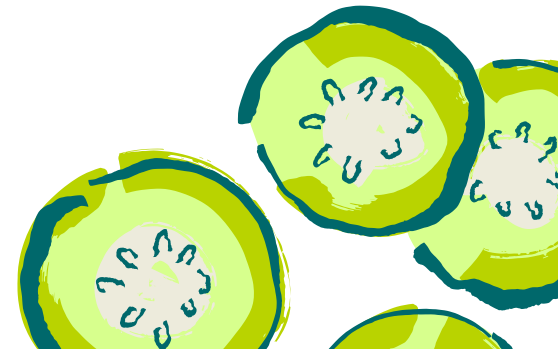
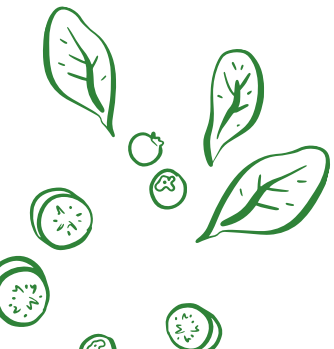

Students of Pal College of Technology and Management from Commerce and Management department visited the Tata Motors Pantnagar Plant for practical industry exposure.

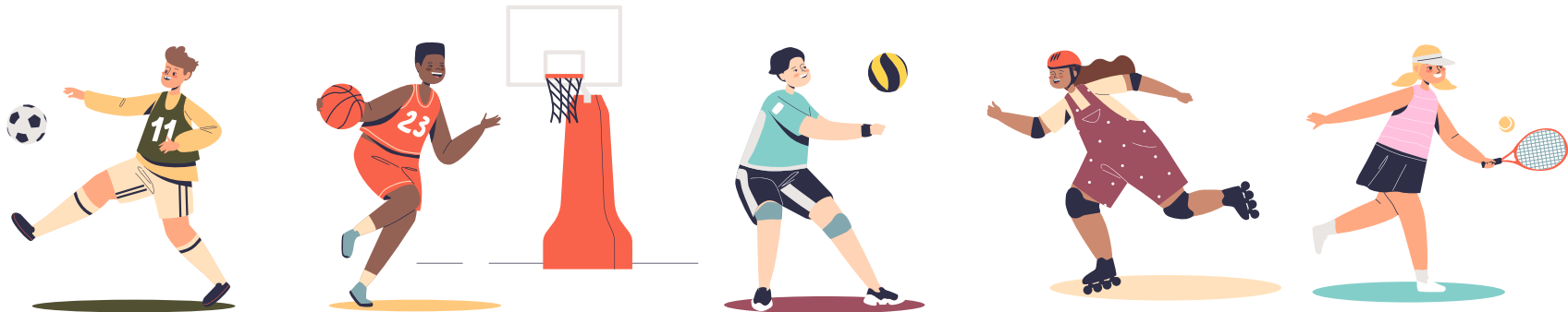
